Turn right onto SW Barbur Ct. (Les Schwab Tire) Turn right at 1st cross street onto SW 26th Way Turn Left onto SW Taylors Ferry Road Destination is 1 block east on left side

From Barbur Blvd East:

Turn slight right onto SW Spring Garden St (behind 7-11 & Jiffy Lube)

Turn left onto SW 26th Way

Turn Left onto SW Taylors Ferry Road Destination is 1 block east on left side
